

Partnership with Parents Policy

Policy's statements of intent:

Bunnahone Bunnies Cross Community Playgroup recognise the importance of working in partnership with parents/carers to promote the best interests of children and that parents play a key role in the education of their children. The playgroup will work in partnership with and support parents in this role.

Procedures

To achieve this, the playgroup will follow procedures:

- Ensure parents/carers are given regular information about their child's progress through informal and formal feedback — verbal and written.
- Welcome the contribution of parents/carers and consult with parents/carers on a regular basis e.g. questionnaires, parents meetings, and informal conversation.
- Have meetings at times and in venues which are accessible and appropriate for all.
- Ensure that all parents/carers are informed about meetings and any other activities being organised by the playgroup.
- Encourage parents/carers to be actively involved in the management committee of the playgroup.
- Inform parents/carers of the procedures for registering comments or complaints.
- Ensure parents/carers are aware of the playgroup policies and procedures.
- Encourage parents/carers to contribute their own skills, knowledge and interests through curriculum activities in the playgroup.
- Encourage parents/carers to help with playgroup outings and fundraising events.
- Providing parents/carers with regular updated information by way of parents booklet, notice board, monthly newsletter (etc.)
