These images may then be used in publicity material (online or print) or just kept for playschool records.

In order to publicise what is happening within the playschool we also invite the press to come along from time to time and children's pictures may appear in newspapers.

In order to comply with the Data Protection Act 1998 we must obtain written parental consent before we take photographs. A consent form will be sent to parents at the beginning of the year.
